- FIDE Blitz rules are valid. All players accept these rules and agree to issued results and pictures on the website of FIDE, the website of the Austrian chess federation and in print medias.
- Tournament will count for the FIDE Blitz rating
- Tie breaks: 1. BH -1, 2. BH, 3. SB, 4. Greater number of victories
